## Background

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### Medium size, research intensive university

- Graduate students (n= 3,600) represent 17% of total student population at Queen's
- > 100 degree programs offered through 50 departments, schools and centres
- 66% of graduate student population is Master's level

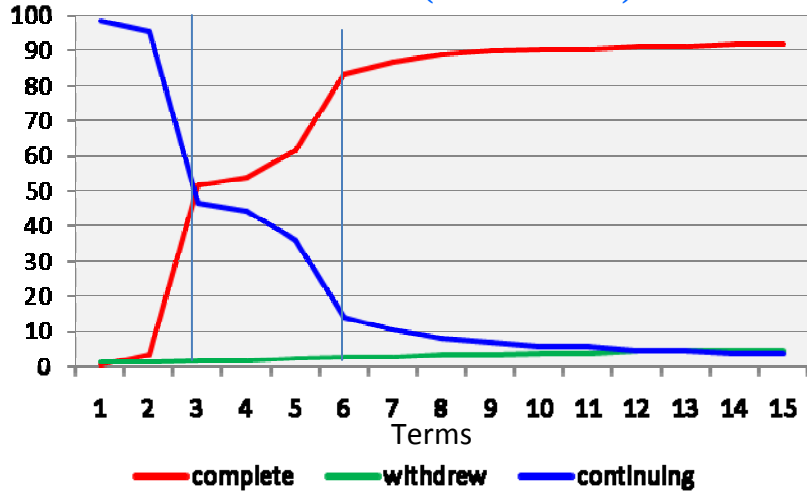




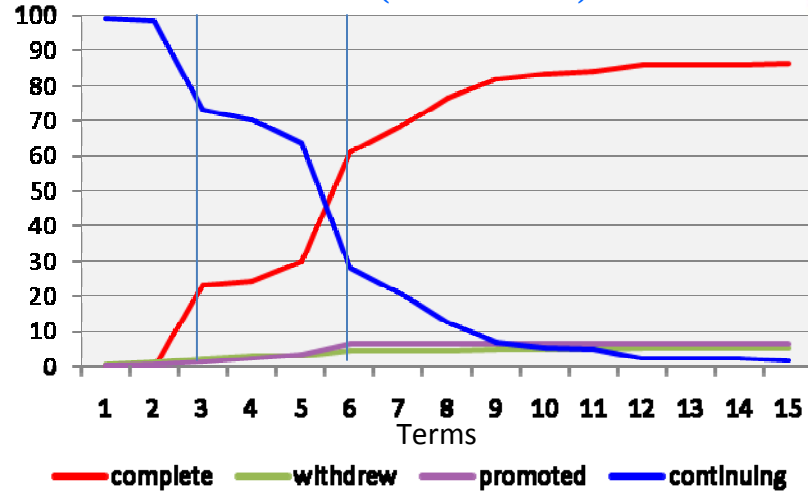

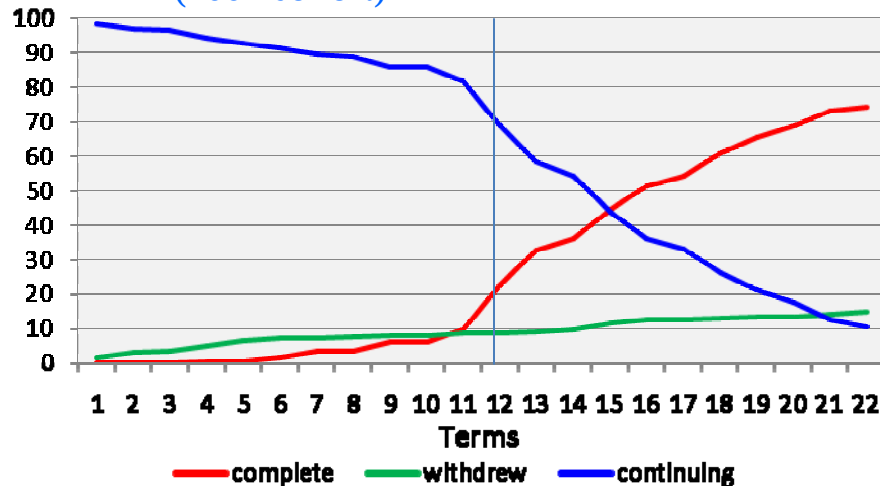
Professional Master's (2004 cohort)

PhD (2002 cohort)



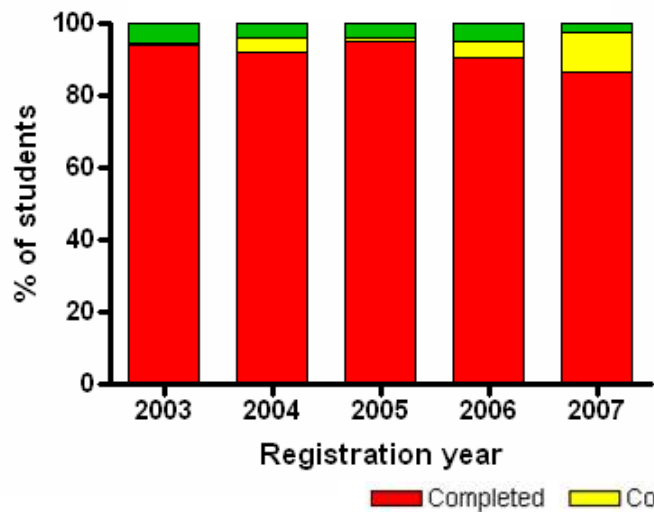




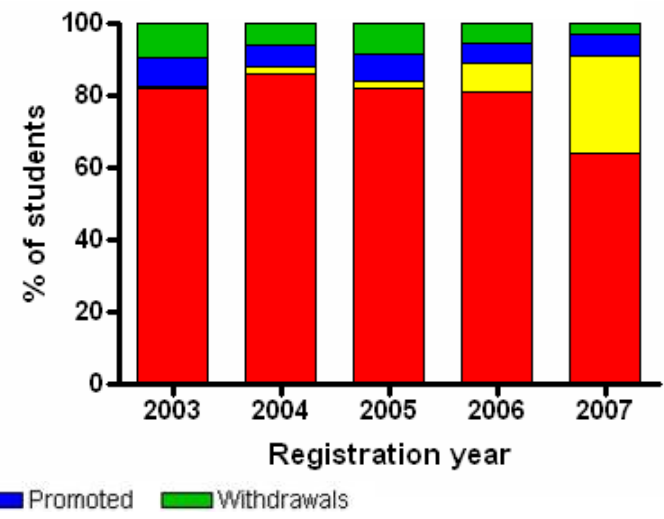

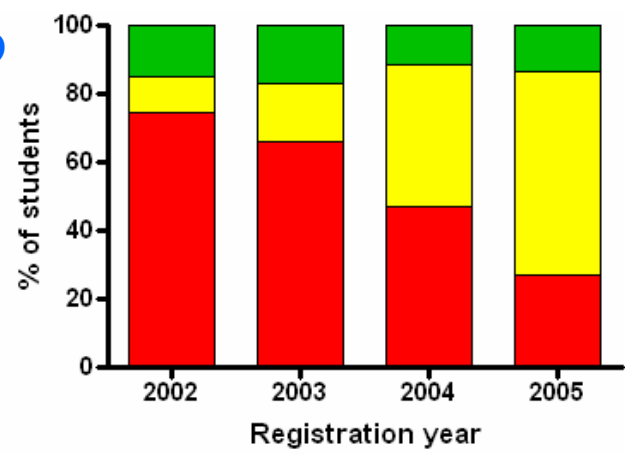
