- Transitioned to undergraduate focused event






Expedited Admissions

- One page application, no fees





Discoveries

- Dine with Dean inclusive environment; changed messaging
- Discovered dearth of data; spurred development of new dashboards
- Process mapping and new workflows



Early Effects

- Programs more amenable to holistic reviews
- Expanded to Quick Admissions Applications
- Moved to test optional and use of graduate certificates to provide access for those outside of the institution
 - Conditional admissions

Quick Admissions

- Open to all undergraduates with a 2.5 or above
- One page application, no fee
- GRE/GMAT (Full)
- Test-optional/Conditional admission
 - o 12 SCH with 3.0 or higher
