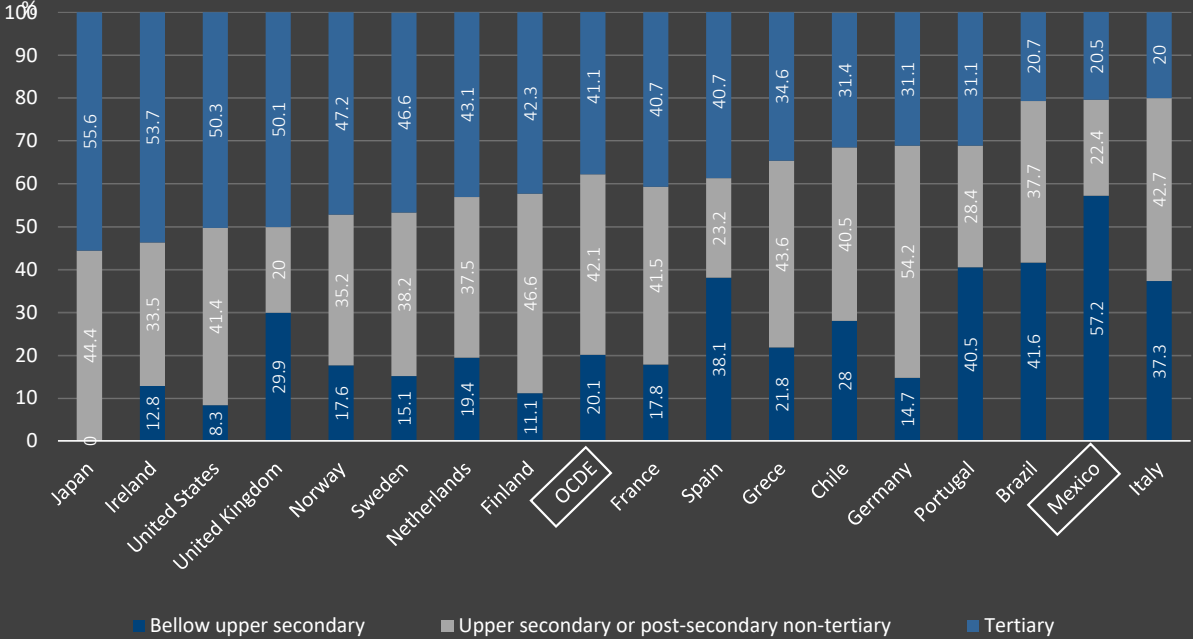

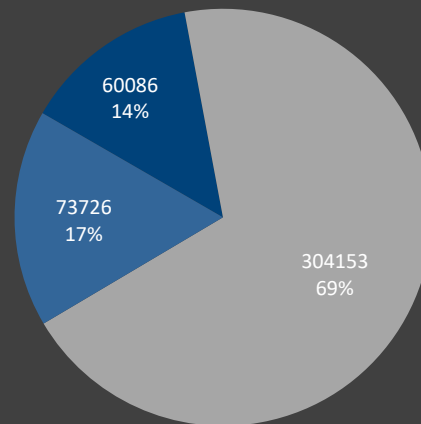
Global educational attainment

Educational attainment of 25-64 year-olds

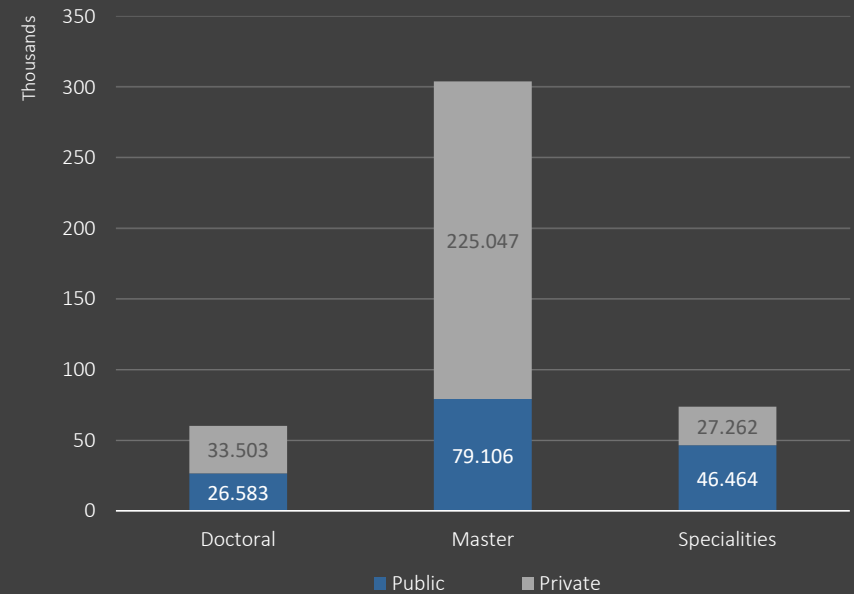


Total Mexico's graduate enrollment

International perspective in the context of graduate studies evaluation in Mexico

Guiding Principles of the **National Policy for Evaluation and Accreditation of Higher Education**.

1. Commitment to **social responsibility** with the preservation, enrichment and dissemination of the goods and values of diverse cultures and a **supportive internationalization**.
2. **Excellence** for the training of professionals with a scientific, technological, innovative, humanistic and **international vision**.
3. **Interculturality** as an ethical-political exercise to value local cultural diversity and with an **international perspective**.
4. Social and gender equity
5. Social innovation.
6. Inclusion.
7. Vanguard.





2023 Global Summit Conclusions

1. Pushing the limits of internationalization **beyond the traditional approach** to include and value all types of knowledge and world visions can enrich graduate education and society in our specific contexts.
2. Looking for creative ways to **overcome the practical challenges of internationalization**, for a more comprehensive international approach, educating about its importance to students, professors and stakeholders is critical for deeper positive and long-lasting effects of international practices.
